In Greek mythology, Ôra or Hora is a group of goddesses representing the change of seasons. The autumn goddess displayed on the label is one of four sculptures found at Cathiard Vineyard, where Hora is produced by the estate's dedicated team.

Bearing the fruit of autumn's harvest, Hora embodies the elegance and harmony of our vineyard which spreads through St. Helena and Rutherford.

Harvest Hand harvested from our oldest hillside vineyard

and valley floor vines.

Winemaking Gentle de-stemming, optical sorting of berries

to ensure the best whole berries are utilized. Grapes are transferred to fermentation vessels by gravity and left to cold soak for up to 5 days. Fermentation temperature maintained under 82F (28C), with gentle manipulations by pump-overs and punch-downs. After 30 days in tanks the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new

French oak.

Barrel-aging 12 months,

40% new French oak.
