Grape variety	100 % Cabernet Sauvignon
Alcohol	14.4 %
Harvest dates	From September 6, 2021 to September 29, 2021
Harvest	Hand-harvested from our oldest and finest hillside vines
Winemaking	Gentle destemming and optical sorting of grapes to ensure the best whole berries are utilized. Grapes are transferred to fermentation vessels by gravity and left to cold soak for up to 5 days. Fermentation temperature maintained under 82F (28C), with gentle manipulations by pump-overs and punch-downs. After 30 days in tanks, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.
Barrel aging	18-20 months 80% new French oak
