## FOUNDING BROTHERS

Napa Valley (St. Helena and Rutherford)

Owners: Florence & Daniel Cathiard Grown, produced and bottled by Cathiard Vineyard

Yields 2 tons/acre (30 hL/ha)

Average vine age 25 years

Bordeaux Blend 59 % Cabernet Sauvignon

32 % Merlot

9 % Cabernet Franc

Alcohol 14.3 %

Harvest dates From September 6, 2021 to September 29, 2021

Harvest Hand-harvested from our hillside and benchland vines

Winemaking Gentle destemming and optical sorting of grapes to

ensure the best whole berries are utilized. Grapes are transferred to fermentation vessels by gravity and left to cold soak for up to 5 days. Fermentation temperature maintained under 82F (28C), with gentle manipulations by pump-overs and punch-downs. After 30 days in tanks, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally

occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak.

Barrel aging 16-18 months

50% new French oak and 20% large foudres
