Napa Valley (St. Helena and Rutherford)

Yields 2 tons/acre (30 hL/ha) Average vine age 18 years Bordeaux Blend 55% Cabernet Sauvignon 35% Merlot 10% Malbec Alcohol 14.1% Harvest dates From September 6, 2021 to September 29, 2021 Harvest Hand-harvested from our youngest benchland vines Winemaking Gentle destemming and optical sorting of grapes to ensure the best whole berries are utilized. Grapes are transferred to fermentation vessels by gravity and left to cold soak for up to 5 days. Fermentation temperature maintained under 82F (28C), with gentle manipulations by pump-overs and punch-downs. After 30 days in tanks, the wine is drained, pressed, and undergoes a naturally occurring malolactic fermentation in new French oak. 14 months **Barrel** aging 40% new French oak
